Are You Bringing in a Speaker: Yes
Description of Speaker (Optional): Olga received a B.S. in Biomedical Engineering from Northwestern University in 2005 and PhD in the same field from Boston University in 2011. Her dissertation work focused on the effect of substrate mechanics on vascular smooth muscle cell behavior in the context of atherosclerosis. Olga switched fields from experimental to computational science as a postdoctoral fellow at Stanford University, following a latent passion for coding and statistical data analysis. She trained in computational genomics, applying next generation sequencing methods to study transcription factor function in the coronary artery. After completing her NRSA post-doctoral fellowship in 2014, Olga moved into industry to focus on the application of genomics to precision medicine. She is currently a computational biologist at 23andMe, where she studies the genetics of Parkinson's Disease. In addition to her career, Olga is a mother to two preschoolers, an avid reader of science fiction, and a mediocre but enthusiastic baker.
