Description of Event:

The event itself will be throughout the whole week and will go as follows:

Day 1:

We introduce the wall of prejudice and its purpose. Ask the participants what they believe prejudice is. Ask them to write up any words that they have been told or heard that exhibit prejudice. Invite them to join us for the rest of the week's events.

Day 2:

We would ask the individuals to take a look at the wall and make observations. Prompt them with questions such as: Which words did you see that were reoccurring? Are there any that surprise you? By chance are there words on the wall that you use in your everyday speech? Why do you think these words could be found offensive by others?

We would ask the participants to write words of encouragement on sticky notes and place them on the wall.

[The sticky notes will later be removed and hung up to decorate around the tabling area to promote positive words and actions]

Day 3:

This would be an opportunity to address social justice issues and specific prejudices that exist in our society. Have different numbered balls in a jar each corresponding to a different type of prejudice (i.e. specific racisms, sexism, homophobia, religious, class, nationalist)

Ask them: What they know about the issue. Why do you think it exists. What is a way to end it.

This would be the day we conduct our photo pledge to do our part to end prejudices

Day 4:

"Cracking Down on Prejudice" Talk about EOP as a philanthropy and the role it takes to provide individuals with a platform to have these conversations.

Invite different campus groups to table with us and expose/interact with the rest of the campus. Promote unity. Have a passport that makes go visit each of the groups; once completed the individual will have the opportunity to throw an egg filled with paint at the wall.

Day 5:

We invite students to help us break down the wall with hammers and/or bats.
